

FLAir: Aerial Rigging Checklist

Minimum Structural and Logistical Requirements to Safely Rig

Minimum height - 10 feet - Trapeze/15 feet - Silks (from floor to rigging point, not ceiling)

- Ladder that reaches 2 feet past the rigging support beam
- Exposed or accessible structural beam
- Metal or Wood beam that actively holds up the building or is built to hold stage lights & speakers
- A working weight load threshold of 2,000 lbs.

* All structural beams will easily meet this requirement. This is specifically for rafters, bolted in metal banisters, overhead bridges and any other structure in question. Information on the working weight load of each beam can be found on the building's blueprints or can be calculated by an engineer. Water lines, air vents, & other features that are secondarily attached to the ceiling will NOT support human weight.

Information about Rigging

FLAir provides all of our own equipment**, rigging, and insists on performing the rigging for these reasons:

- The Convenience of the client.
- FLAir inspects/maintains the equipment for the personal safety of our team.

** Except for ladders and lifts.

Once access is gained to the point to be rigged (via ladder or cherry picker), it usually only takes about 15 minutes to rig/inspect. Once FLAir has set up at a venue for the first time, subsequent riggings will be easier.

Equipment is easily "flown in & out" by tie lines. To "fly in" the equipment takes 30 seconds and apparatus are out of the way for the rest of the event. Equipment removal will be performed by FLAir and scheduled with the event contact person to fit everyone's schedule.
